



protect your dogs

Ehrlichiosis, an exotic tick-borne dog disease, has been confirmed in the Northern Territory and Western Australia. Prevention is the best protection for dogs as vaccinations are not presently available.

- Have your dogs on a tick control program.
- Ensure any tick infestations in the house yard are managed by a pest controller.
- Avoid taking your dogs into tick-infested areas.
- Take particular care when bush-walking with your dog.
- Inspect your dogs daily for ticks, especially if they have been in a tick-infested areas.
- Be on the lookout for signs of ehrlichiosis.
