Ehrlichiosis

Protect your dog

Ehrlichiosis, a tick-borne dog disease, has been detected in the Northern Territory and is present in most local government areas, including Darwin, Palmerston, Darwin rural area, Katherine and many remote communities.

Ehrlichiosis is a bacterial disease spread by the brown dog tick. Once the disease is in the brown dog tick population it's very difficult to control, particularly in the tropical and subtropical regions.

Prevention is the best protection as vaccinations are not available.

Protect your dog from ehrlichiosis

- Have your dogs on a tick control program. Tick collars and spot-ons are the best primary protection used in combination with tablets and chews registered for tick control.
- Ensure any tick infestations in the house yard are managed by a pest controller.
- Avoid taking your dogs into tick-infested areas.
- Take care when bush-walking with your dog.

Inspect your dogs daily for ticks

- Run your fingers through your pet's coat over their skin, feeling for abnormal bumps.
- Pay attention to the head, neck and ears, chest, between their toes and around their mouths and gums.

- Remove ticks carefully using a tick remover or fine tipped forceps, grabbing it as close to the skin as possible avoiding squeezing the body of the tick.
- Kill the tick by putting it in alcohol, into a sealed container and then into the rubbish.

Prevent ticks from biting your dog

- Use a tick control product which repels ticks, such as a tick collar or spot-on. Products which rely on the tick biting the dog to work may not prevent ehrlichiosis. Ask your vet for advice about which product best suits your needs.
- Controlling ticks in your environment is critical. Ticks can live in cracks and crevices around your house and yard, around kennels, and inside skirting boards, window and door frames and can survive for many months without feeding. Speak with a professional pest controller about treating your home.

Travelling or boarding your dog?

Before hitting the road:

- Check in with your vet to assess disease prevention requirements such as vaccination, worming, tick and flea control, heartworm preventive.
- When travelling avoid contact with other dogs when stopping, such as at fuel stations, truck stops or caravan parks, to avoid disease transmission between dogs.
- When boarding your dog, make sure their tick, flea, worm and vaccinations are up to date. Check with your local boarding kennel on mandatory disease prevention requirements.

Look out for signs

- fever
- lethargy
- loss of appetite
- weight loss
- swelling of the chest or front legs
- cloudy eyes or conjunctivitis
- pain and stiffness
- bleeding disorders such as nosebleeds or bruising on the gums or belly.

It's important to seek veterinary advice and treatment as ehrlichiosis can resemble other tick-borne dog diseases already present in the Territory. Early treatment provides the best chance of recovery.

If you suspect your dog is showing signs of the disease, report it your local vet or call the national Emergency Animal Disease Watch hotline on 1800 675 888.

FCI SUSPENSIONS

The **Kinoloski Savez Republike Srbije (KSS)** informs the FCI members and contract partners that **Mrs Mirjana Petrić (RS210)** has been suspended as international show judge, for a period of 1 year, from **15/04/2021** until **14/04/2022**. The FCI Judges Directory has also been updated by the KSS accordingly.

The **Ente Nazionale della Cinofilia Italiana (ENCI)** informs the FCI members and contract partners about the provisional suspension of the Ceskoslovenský Vlcák dogs (list link below) since **18/01/2021**. As a result and until further notice, the dogs on that list cannot

- be used for breeding,
- take part in national or international canine events,
- get the CACIB/CACIT/CACITR or international champion titles homologated by the FCI.

The awards and titles obtained since **18/01/2021** are provisionally suspended.

We thank you for forwarding this decision to all the stakeholders of your national canine scene.

ANKC JACK RUSSELL TERRIER SURVEY

This survey applies to any Member of a Canine Control affiliated with the ANKC Ltd who is the owner of a registered Jack Russell Terrier. In the interests of the breed, please read this survey carefully and complete the online survey. Responses to the survey are required by **28 August 2021**.

PROPOSAL

The ANKC Ltd have resolved to conduct a Survey of all Jack Russell Terrier owners recommending that the following changes to the Breed Standard be endorsed:

BODY

Chest deep rather than wide, with good clearance and the brisket located at the height mid-way between the ground and the withers. The body should be proportioned marginally longer than tall, **measuring slightly longer from the withers to the root of the tail than from the withers to the ground the length from the point of the shoulder to the buttocks slightly greater than the height from the withers to the ground**. Back level. Ribs should be well sprung from the spine, flattening on the sides so that the girth behind the elbows can be spanned by two hands - about 40 cms to 43 cms. The loins should be short, strong and deeply muscled.

The change is to replace the wording highlighted in **red** with the highlighted wording in **bold**.

A majority of registered owners within the breed and responding to this survey must be in favour before approval is given by the ANKC Ltd.

RATIONALE

This brings the Standard in line with the Country of origin UK standard.

The ANKC standard gives totally the wrong body proportions by measuring from the withers to the root of the tail versus the point of shoulder to the buttocks in the Kennel Club standard.

SUMMARY OF THE ANKC LTD SPECIAL BOARD MEETING HELD VIA ZOOM VIDEO CONFERENCING ON 19th JUNE, 2021

At the June 2021 ANKC Ltd Special Board meeting, Directors resolved/considered the following:

1. Ehrlichiosis in Dogs

It was RESOLVED to publish on the ANKC and all Member Body websites and social media pages an article authored by Dr Karen Hedberg BVSc, Chairperson of the ANKC Canine Health & Wellbeing Committee, regarding an emerging disease – Ehrlichiosis in Dogs.

2. * ANKC Ltd Canine Hip & Elbow Dysplasia Report Submission Form: Amendment

It was RESOLVED to that the ANKC Ltd Canine Hip & Elbow Dysplasia Report Submission Form be amended to include a check box confirming the dog has not previously been scored under the ANKC Ltd Canine Hip & Elbow Dysplasia Scheme.

3. * ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration

It was RESOLVED that **Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration, Section 8 – Breeding, Clause 8.17.2** be amended with the addition of dot point (g) to read:

8.17.2 *Once agreed they should develop a proposed breed survey rationale, with questions that must be answered and a proposed date of commencement (after the Breed Survey (BS) is completed). The following outline should be followed to develop the required breed survey:*

- a. Description of the condition;*
- b. Severity of the condition designated as a problem in the breed;*
- c. Mode of inheritance if known;*
- d. Percentage (with known DNA testable conditions) of affected carrier and normal in the current population. These can be obtained from the major testing facilities both locally and overseas;*
- e. Desired breeding strategy for DNA testable diseases - with the desired strategy being to not produce any more affected progeny and at the same time keep as diverse a gene pool as possible.*
- f. For non DNA testable diseases the breeding aim is to lower the incidence of severe inherited disease across the breed as a whole.*
- g. And are of sufficient maturity from which to be bred.**

Note: This amendment to the regulations will be effective 1 January 2022.

4. * ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration

It was RESOLVED that **Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration, Section 8 – Breeding, Clause 8.17.4** be amended to read:

8.17.4 *Once the final wording has been accepted, the BS made available to all owners and breeders of the breed involved in each State/Territory journal, website and social media pages in a timely manner.*

Note: This amendment to the regulations will be effective 1 January 2022.

SUMMARY OF THE ANKC LTD SPECIAL BOARD MEETING HELD VIA ZOOM VIDEO CONFERENCING ON 19th JUNE, 2021

5. * ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration

It was RESOLVED that ANKC allow inter-variety breeding of Peruvian Hairless Dogs in accordance with FCI regulations effective from 1 July 2021.

As a result, **Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration, Section 9 – Breed Varieties – Judging & Interbreeding, Clause 9.14** will be amended to read:

9.14 Peruvian Hairless Dog – Small: Peruvian Hairless Dog – Medium: Peruvian Hairless Dog – Large (Amended 10/13 – 5.6.4)

- a.. Judged separately with each variety receiving separate Challenge Certificates.
- b. Inter variety breeding is approved, only bred to the nearest variety in size – or risk of whelping problems.
- c. Reclassified on size type is permitted as follows:
 - 1) Where a Peruvian Hairless Dog fails to reach or develops beyond the height for which it is registered then, up to twelve months of age, it may be measured and re-registered within the actual size that the dog has achieved.
 - 2) Three [3] licensed judges selected by ANKC Ltd shall carry out the measuring.
 - 3) The three [3] judges shall be residents of the same State or Territory as that in, which the dog resides.
 - 4) The measuring device used shall be that approved by ANKC Ltd.
 - 5) Any challenge points awarded to the dog under the size of its original registration shall be cancelled, upon re-registration. **(10/07, 6.2.7)**
- d. **LONG COAT** Long coat to long coat will always give long coat (as a single recessive gene).
- e. **COLOUR** Never breed Merle to Merle – ¼ will be homozygote for lethal/health defects, such as deafness

Note: This amendment to the regulations will be effective 1 July 2021.

6. * ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 8 – Member Bodies & Membership

It was RESOLVED that **Regulations Part 8-Member Bodies & Membership, Section 6: Stationery/Certificates** be amended to read:-

“I certify that this exhibit has not within the said period of three weeks been in premises affected with Distemper, Canine Hepatitis, Parvo Virus or any other contagious disease and is currently vaccinated in accordance with current World Small Animal Veterinary Association International Vaccination Committee (WSAVA IVC) policies.” (10/09, 8.10) (Amended 10/15, 6.1.8) (Amended 06/21, 4.2)

Note: This amendment to the regulations will be effective 1 January 2022.

7. * ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 3N – Regulations for the Conduct of Scent Work Trials/Judges Training Scheme

It was RESOLVED that Regulations 3N – Regulations for the Conduct of Scent Work Trials/Judges Training Scheme, **Clause 1.1** be amended to read:

1.1 Responsibility for the accreditation of Scent Work Judges will rest with:

1. the ANKC National Scent Work Committee, for a period of twelve months (1) year from the date of implementation.
2. thereafter the relevant Member Body through its Scent Work Sub-Committee.

Note: This amendment to the regulations will be effective 1 January 2022.
