Ehrlichiosis

Treatment for your dog

Ehrlichiosis, a tick-borne dog disease, has been detected in the Northern Territory and is present in most local government areas, including Darwin, Palmerston, Darwin rural area, Katherine and many remote communities.

Ehrlichiosis is a bacterial disease spread by the brown dog tick. If your dog has been diagnosed with ehrlichiosis, it is important that you follow some simple measures to protect the health of your dog and your community.

Treatment plan

- Follow the ehrlichiosis treatment plan recommended by your vet.
- Complete the long course of antibiotics prescribed by your vet.

Early antibiotic treatment provides the best chance of recovery. In some cases very sick dogs may need supportive care and hospitalisation.

Tick prevention program

- Have your dogs on a tick control program. Tick collars and spot-ons are the best primary protection used in combination with tablets and chews registered for tick control. Treat all the dogs at the same time.

Talk to your vet about which product is best suited to your needs.

You should always:

- follow label instructions
- provide regular treatments on time - a reminder in your phone can help!

Check your dog for ticks

- Regularly check your dogs for ticks.
- Run your fingers through your pet's coat over their skin, feeling for abnormal bumps. Pay particular attention to the head, neck and ears, chest, between their toes and around their mouths and gums.
- Kill the tick by putting it in alcohol, into a sealed container and then into the rubbish.

Treating your environment

- Speak with a professional pest controller about treating your home environment to break the cycle of infection.

Ticks can live in cracks and crevices around your house and yard, around kennels, and inside skirting boards, window and door frames where they can survive for many months without feeding.

Ticks that feed on an infected dog can go on to infect other dogs. Controlling ticks in your environment is important to break the transmission cycle of the disease.

Don't move your dog

- Don't move your dog away from your hometown or community until it is recovered, as this could spread disease to other areas.
- If you need to move your dog(s), wait until it's treatment is finished. Contact your vet to check your dog is healthy and ensure your tick control treatment is current.

Look for signs in other dogs

- If any other dogs become unwell, especially with fever, lethargy, loss of appetite, weightloss, cloudy eyes or conjunctivitis, pain and stiffness, bleeding disorders such as nosebleeds or bruising on the gums or belly, contact your vet immediately so they can be checked for ehrlichiosis.

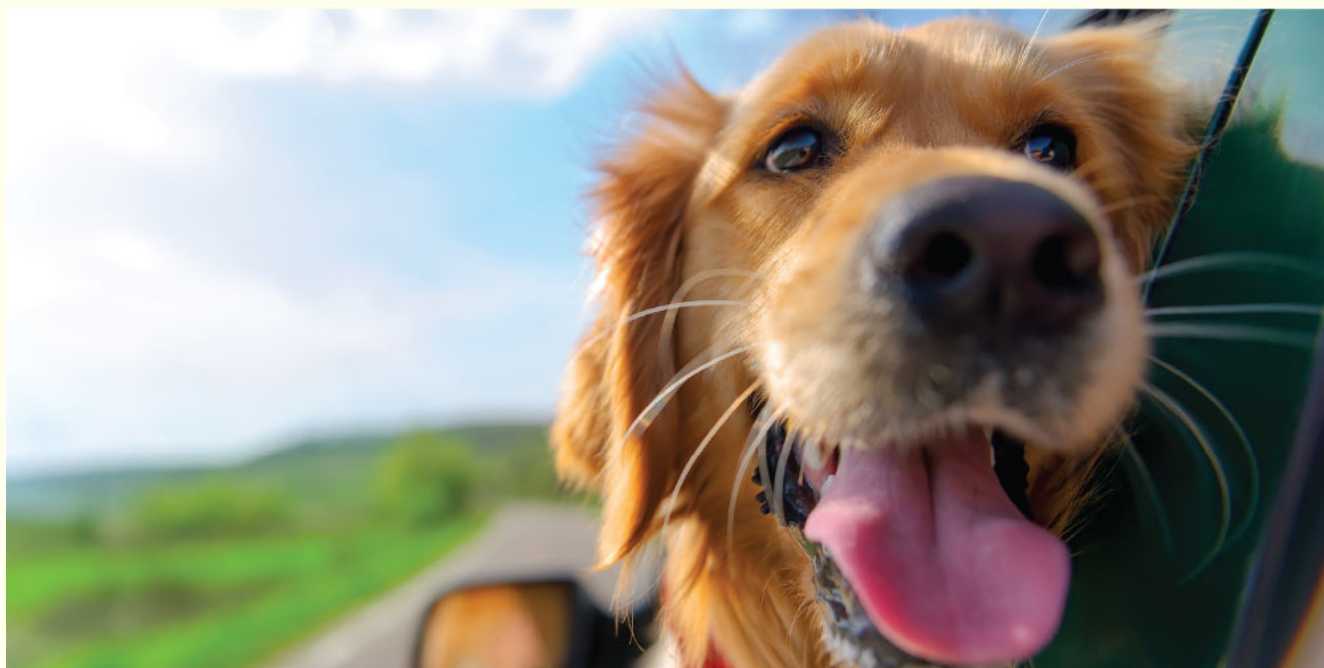
Human health

- The disease cannot be directly passed from infected dogs to humans.
- In extremely rare cases, ticks infected with *Ehrlichia canis* may infect people. Human ehrlichiosis is almost always caused by species other than *Ehrlichia canis* and these species have not yet been found in Australia.

It's important to seek veterinary advice and treatment as ehrlichiosis can resemble other tick-borne dog diseases already present in the Territory. Early treatment provides the best chance of recovery.

If you suspect your dog is showing signs of the disease, report it your local vet or call the national Emergency Animal Disease Watch hotline on 1800 675 888.

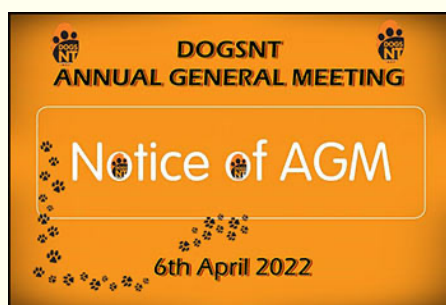

ANKC MEMBER UPDATE



On Sunday October 24th, the ANKC conducted an important update to its members detailing its plan to rebrand the public face of the Australian National Kennel Council to **Dogs Australia** and take a more proactive role in communicating to dog lovers nationally. The update also demonstrated the scale and strength of the combined member bodies across Australia. The purpose of the presentation was to brief members for feedback ahead of a public launch of Dogs Australia which will take place later this year. The official Dogs Australia launch date will be advised to members in the coming weeks.

Dogs Australia will change the way we communicate with dog lovers around Australia.



With its name change or re-branding will be the beginning of a much bigger and more pro-active marketing role for our national body. Across Australia we have 32,000 members, 11,000 breeders and over 350 breed clubs and now we will have a much stronger voice and, in time, a much bigger public voice.

OCTOBER 2021 AGM & BOARD MEETING SUMMARY

At the recent Annual General Meeting of the Australian National Kennel Council Limited held via Zoom video conferencing:

1. ELECTION OF ANKC LTD EXECUTIVE:

- Mr Hugh Gent OAM was re-elected unopposed as President for a three-year term from 16 October 2021.
- Ms Pam Campbell was elected unopposed as Vice President for a one-year term from 16 October 2021.
- Mr David Sales was re-elected unopposed as Treasurer for a one-year term from 16 October 2021.
- Mrs Ulla Greenwood was elected as a member of the Executive Committee for a one-year term from 16 October 2021.

At the October 2021 ANKC Ltd Board meeting, Directors resolved/considered the following:

2. DANCES WITH DOGS JUDGES – FCI JUDGES LISTING:

FCI has confirmed all FCI discipline Judges can be added to the FCI Judges Directory if they comply with FCI qualifications. A notice will be distributed to ANKC Member Bodies in due course confirming how interested Australian Judges can arrange to be included on the Directory.

3. MURRAY RIVER RETRIEVER – RECOGNITION:

It was resolved to formally recognise the Murray River Retriever as a breed under development as from 1 January 2022 in accordance with Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration, Section 10.

4. AUSTRALASIAN BOSDOG – RECOGNITION:

It was resolved to formally recognise the Australasian Bosdog as a breed under development as from 1 January 2022 in accordance with Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration, Section 10.

5. ROTTWEILER BREED SURVEY:

It was resolved that ANKC conduct a survey of all Rottweiler breeders and owners to determine whether the dogs with natural bob tails should be placed on the Limited Register. The results of the survey will be considered by the ANKC Board.

6. JACK RUSSELL TERRIER SURVEY:

It was resolved that the results of the Jack Russell Terrier survey be endorsed and for the breed standard to be amended as follows:

Body

Chest deep rather than wide, with good clearance and the brisket located at the height mid-way between the ground and the withers. The body should be proportioned marginally longer than tall, **measuring slightly longer from the withers to the root of the tail than from the withers to the ground the length from the point of the shoulder to the buttocks slightly greater than the height from the withers to the ground.** Back level. Ribs should be well sprung from the spine, flattening on the sides so that the girth behind the elbows can be spanned by two hands - about 40 cms to 43 cms. The loins should be short, strong and deeply muscled.

The change will be to replace the wording highlighted in red with the highlighted wording in **bold**. To be effective immediately.

8. IDENTIFICATION OF NATURAL BOB TAIL (NBT) ON THE ANKC LTD BUSINESS SYSTEM:

It was resolved that the recorded information of Natural Bob Tail, identified on the pedigree database as 'NBT', as part of the printed information that appears as part of a dog's registered name or number, ensuring that this information is included in relation to their official identification. To be effective from 1 July 2022.

9. IDENTIFICATION OF LEGALLY SHORTENED TAIL (LST) ON THE ANKC LTD BUSINESS SYSTEM:

It was resolved to implement an identification code of 'LST', noting a Legally Shortened Tail, to be added to the dog's name as a suffix pursuant to receipt of a certificate verifying that the dog has had this Veterinary procedure in line with legislation. To be effective from 1 July 2022.

AND

It was resolved the implementation of 'LST' be endorsed on the registrations of all dogs that have been previously registered under Vet Certification that they have a Legally Shortened Tail. To be effective from 1 July 2022.

10. NATURAL BOBTAIL DOBERMANN:

It was resolved for any Dobermann applying to be registered as a Natural Bobtail ('NBT') must show DNA proof of purity of breed and a positive NBT DNA result effective from 1 January 2022.

11. ANKC LTD / AUSTRALIAN FLYBALL ASSOCIATION (AFA) AGREEMENT:

It was resolved to endorse the new agreement which will become effective from 9 February 2022, immediately following the expiration of the previous agreement. The new Agreement will apply for a period of five years.
