

DOGS NT 2022 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

RETURNING OFFICE REPORT

This report has been prepared for presentation at the Dogs NT Annual General Meeting to be conducted on 6 April 2022. Many thanks to DogsNT for asking me to be the Returning Officer. This is not a position I take lightly.

Nominations were called for Vice President, Secretary and three (3) Councillor positions and closed on 2 February 2022. A ballot was not required as nominations did not exceed the vacant positions.

Position of Vice President – 1 nomination – the Vice President is Carolwyn Beckett.

Position of Secretary – no nominations – the position of Secretary is to be dealt with by Council as a casual vacancy.

Positions for Councillor (3) – 3 nominations, one of whom was successful in the Vice President position – the successful candidates are:

Councillor – the vacant position is to be dealt with by Council as a casual vacancy.
