

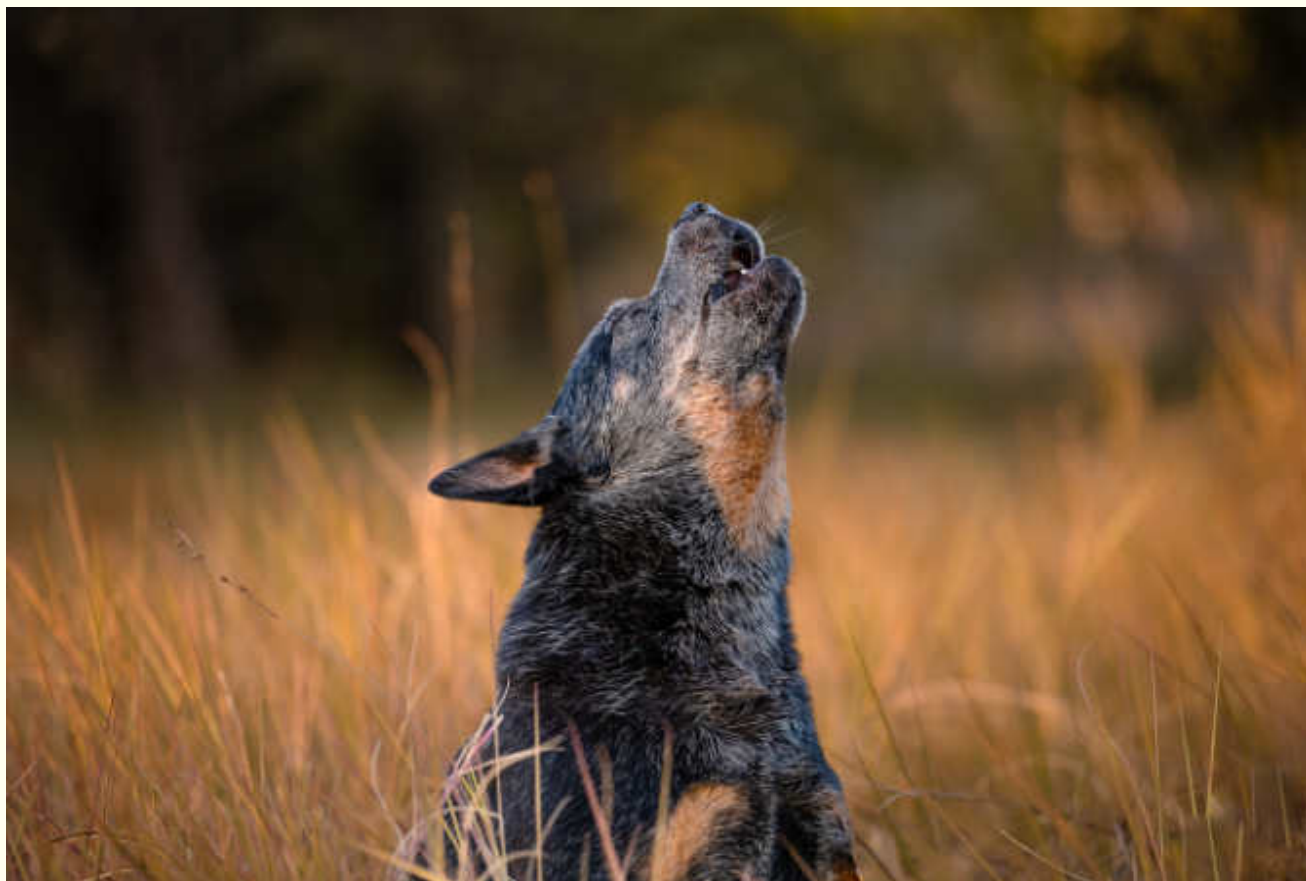

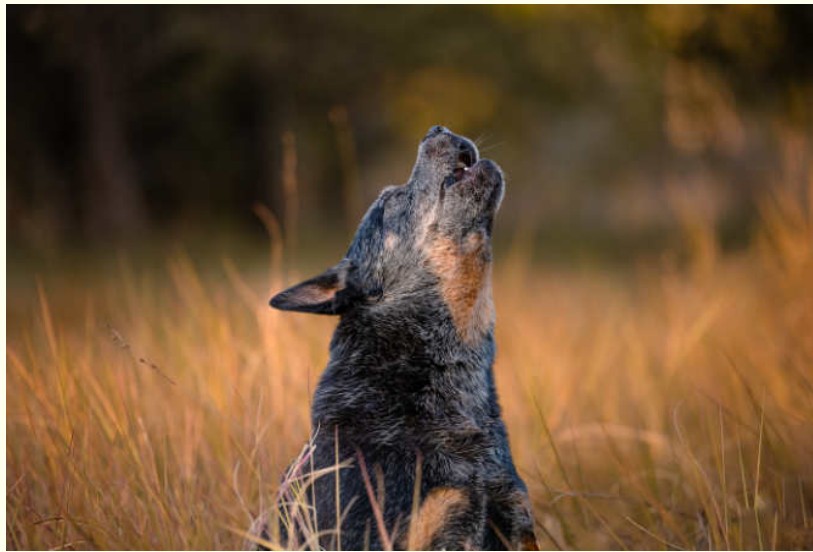

EHRLICHIOSIS: TREATMENT AND PREVENTION

Remember, the tick-borne dog disease Ehrlichiosis has been confirmed in Northern Territory.

We need your help to spread the word that the tick-borne dog disease Ehrlichiosis has been detected in the Territory. Biosecurity is a shared responsibility, and we need your support to build community awareness of everyone's role to stop the transmission of the bacteria *Ehrlichia canis*.

Ehrlichiosis is transmitted to dogs by the brown dog tick, which is widespread in northern Australia. Prevention is the best protection for dogs as vaccinations are not presently available. All dog owners are strongly encouraged to have their dogs on a tick control program, regularly check their dogs for ticks, and be on the lookout for signs of the disease.

DOGSNT RULE CHANGES

SECTION 3 – EXHIBITIONS

PREVIOUS RULE:

3.38 - EXHIBITION PAPERWORK

3.38.1: Properly compiled chart(s) must be provided for each exhibition (hard copy or electronic). Chart/s must be signed by the Judge (hand-signed or electronic signature). The Exhibition Manager shall retain for at least three (3) months from the last day of the Exhibition; any documentation not submitted to the NACA. (19/05/2022)

AMENDED RULE:

3.38 - EXHIBITION PAPERWORK

3.38.1: A properly compiled catalogue and appropriate way of recording results must be provided for each exhibition (hard copy or electronic). The Exhibition Manager must retain for at least three (3) months from the last day of the Exhibition; any documentation not submitted to the NACA. (09/06/2022)

PREVIOUS RULE:

3.38 – EXHIBITION PAPERWORK

3.38.2 The Exhibition Manager shall forward to the NACA, within ten (10) days of the closing of the Exhibition, an official Catalogue containing a full and correct list of all entries and with all the awards and absentees correctly marked therein, the Ring Stewards charts, and Exhibition Manager's report.

NEW RULE:

3.38 – EXHIBITION PAPERWORK

3.38.2 The Exhibition Manager shall forward to the NACA, within ten (10) days of the closing of the Exhibition, an official Catalogue containing a full and correct list of all entries and with all the awards and absentees correctly marked therein, the Ring Stewards charts (if any), and Exhibition Manager's report. (09/06/2022)

Ehrlichiosis

Treatment for your dog

Ehrlichiosis, a tick-borne dog disease, has been detected in the Northern Territory and is present in most local government areas, including Darwin, Palmerston, Darwin rural area, Katherine and many remote communities.

Ehrlichiosis is a bacterial disease spread by the brown dog tick. If your dog has been diagnosed with ehrlichiosis, it is important that you follow some simple measures to protect the health of your dog and your community.

Treatment plan

- Follow the ehrlichiosis treatment plan recommended by your vet.
- Complete the long course of antibiotics prescribed by your vet.

Early antibiotic treatment provides the best chance of recovery. In some cases very sick dogs may need supportive care and hospitalisation.

Tick prevention program

- Have your dogs on a tick control program. Tick collars and spot-ons are the best primary protection used in combination with tablets and chews registered for tick control. Treat all the dogs at the same time.

Talk to your vet about which product is best suited your needs.

You should always:

- follow label instructions
- provide regular treatments on time - a reminder in your phone can help!

Check your dog for ticks

- Regularly check your dogs for ticks.
- Run your fingers through your pet's coat over their skin, feeling for abnormal bumps. Pay particular attention to the head, neck and ears, chest, between their toes and around their mouths and gums.
- Kill the tick by putting it in alcohol, into a sealed container and then into the rubbish.

Treating your environment

- Speak with a professional pest controller about treating your home environment to break the cycle of infection.

Ticks can live in cracks and crevices around your house and yard, around kennels, and inside skirting boards, window and door frames where they can survive for many months without feeding.

Ticks that feed on an infected dog can go on to infect other dogs. Controlling ticks in your environment is important to break the transmission cycle of the disease.

Don't move your dog

- Don't move your dog away from your hometown or community until it is recovered, as this could spread disease to other areas.
- If you need to move your dog(s), wait until it's treatment is finished. Contact your vet to check your dog is healthy and ensure your tick control treatment is current.

Look for signs in other dogs

- If any other dogs become unwell, especially with fever, lethargy, loss of appetite, weightloss, cloudy eyes or conjunctivitis, pain and stiffness, bleeding disorders such as nosebleeds or bruising on the gums or belly, contact your vet immediately so they can be checked for ehrlichiosis.

Human health

- The disease cannot be directly passed from infected dogs to humans.
- In extremely rare cases, ticks infected with *Ehrlichia canis* may infect people. Human ehrlichiosis is almost always caused by species other than *Ehrlichia canis* and these species have not yet been found in Australia.

It's important to seek veterinary advice and treatment as ehrlichiosis can resemble other tick-borne dog diseases already present in the Territory. Early treatment provides the best chance of recovery.

If you suspect your dog is showing signs of the disease, report it your local vet or call the national Emergency Animal Disease Watch hotline on 1800 675 888.

DOGS AUSTRALIA: FRENCH BULLDOG BREED STANDARD - AMENDMENT



We have received advice that the Kennel Club (UK) has amended the breed standard for the French Bulldog and the following changes have been confirmed by the National Breed Standards Coordination Group Chairperson, Marie Merchant.

Head And Skull:

Head square in appearance and in proportion to dog's size. Skull nearly flat between ears, domed forehead. The skin covering the skull and forehead should be supple enough to allow fine wrinkling when the dog is alert. **Well defined muzzle, that can clearly be viewed in profile**, broad, deep and set back, muscles of cheeks well developed. Stop well defined. Lower jaw deep, square, broad, slightly undershot and turned up. Nose black and wide, relatively short, with **visibly** open nostrils and line between well defined. Lips black, thick, meeting each other in centre, completely hiding teeth. Upper lip covers lower on each side with plenty of cushion, never so exaggerated as to hang too much below level of lower jaw.

Eyes:

Preferably dark and matching. Moderate size, round, neither sunken or prominent, showing no white when looking straight forward; set **moderately** ~~relatively~~ wide apart and on the same level as the stop.

Neck:

Powerful, well-arched and ~~thick~~, of moderate length.
[The word "thick" is removed]

Tail:

Undocked, ~~short~~, set low. Thick at root, tapering quickly towards tip, preferably straight and long enough to cover anus. Never curling over back no carried gaily.
[The word "short" is removed]

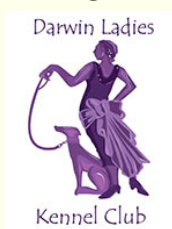
