Treacle has also won multiple Best in Group, Runner Up in Group and In Show awards. She is well on her way to her Supreme Champion title. I am indebted to Treacle's breeder Mr Max Winch for this wonderful dog, a joy to own, a joy to show, and a joy to have.

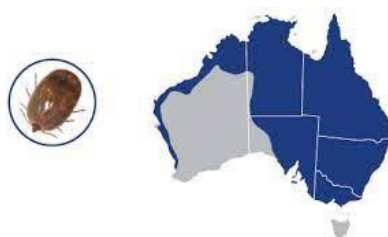

DOGS AUSTRALIA: EHRLICHIOSIS IN DOGS



DISTRIBUTION OF THE BROWN TICK IN AUSTRALIA

Currently, as of early 2023, the disease has been reported in the Mount Isa area and as far east as Townsville. All people travelling with dogs into north Queensland, the Northern Territory, the far north of Western Australia and northern South Australia should be taking precautions against ticks.

All dogs should have 'Serresto'[™] tick collars on prior to entering these areas and stay on tick preventatives for several weeks following. If you are using other oral products for flea, heartworm and tick control, these can continue to be used. The aim is to prevent the tick from biting the dog; these collars repel the ticks.

Ehrlichiosis is a tick-borne disease affecting primarily dogs but equally affects dingoes and foxes. It is not transmitted from dog to dog, transmission only occurs through infected ticks, the main one being the brown dog tick.

The brown dog tick is widespread throughout mainland Australia. No brown ticks have been found in Tasmania. While some ticks are mostly coastal, the brown dog tick is found extensively throughout the Australian continent. Ehrlichiosis is a disease that is caused by a tick-borne bacteria called Ehrlichia Canis. Once a dog has been bitten by an infected tick, there are 3 stages of infection;

1. Acute or early phase (3-4 weeks)
2. A subclinical phase (months to years)
3. Chronic or long-term stage. (months to years)

SYMPTOMS INCLUDE;

- fever,
- lethargy,
- enlarged lymph nodes,
- loss of appetite,
- discharge from the eyes and nose,
- weight loss,
- anaemia, and;
- bleeding disorders such as nosebleeds or bleeding under the skin that looks like small spots, patches or bruising.

The severity of symptoms varies considerably between dogs. The incubation period is 1-3 weeks after the tick bite, but the chronic form may not manifest for months or years following infection. PCR and ELISA tests give the most accurate diagnosis along with comprehensive blood tests. Affected dogs require veterinary treatment and supportive care, the earlier this is diagnosed and treated the better.

DOGS AUSTRALIA: EHRLICHIOSIS IN DOGS (CONTINUED):



Usually, these dogs are treated with tetracycline drugs for a minimum of 4 weeks, shorter treatment periods may result in subclinical carriers. Seronegative PCR tests will indicate if the infection has cleared. **IF NOT PROPERLY TREATED THESE DOGS CAN AND DO DIE.**

DISTRIBUTION

This disease can be found worldwide, particularly in tropical and subtropical areas. Once the disease is in the brown dog tick population, it is very difficult to control. **German Shepherds and Siberian Huskies are predisposed to develop more severe signs of disease with a worse prognosis (reduced cell-mediated immune response).** In extremely rare cases, infected ticks may infect people, however, the species of Ehrlichia that affects humans has not yet been detected in Australia.

Ehrlichiosis is currently a notifiable disease. While this disease was first reported in the far north of Western Australia in the middle of 2020. Since that time, cases have also been found throughout the Northern Territory where it is now considered endemic, right down to the South Australian border. A case has been found recently in Mount Isa where the infected dog has no history of ever leaving the state. At the rate this is moving, no state will be safe and all people who travel with their dogs should be aware of the risks and the need to provide preventative measures to protect their dogs.

Dogs from affected areas are being monitored and their movement is limited (at this stage). Dogs (including rescue dogs) moving out from these areas are required to test negative. Healthy dogs should be on an effective tick control program.

PREVENTION

The aim is to prevent tick bites in the first place so as to avoid the dog getting the disease. The best prevention is to use Tick collars of which 'Serresto'™ is the best as it repels ticks.

Secondly, have a good tick and flea control program in place so that if a tick does get on the dog, it will be killed. There are quite a few products that can be used but ensure the dog is not left unprotected by running late with treatments.

- Avoid taking dogs into tick-infected areas such as bush and long grass, particularly in coastal areas.
- Inspect your dog daily for ticks for 5-6 days after being in tick-infected areas.
- Check bedding and treat with anti-parasite sprays if in a tick area.

TRAVELLING

The most likely way this disease will spread is by the transport of dogs interstate. Dog exhibitors like to travel far and wide for shows, often interstate. We should all be vigilant with providing tick control measures and renewing these before we travel! Do not take dogs running along beaches, through the bush etc without adequate tick prevention. Be aware at some shows, the grounds may back onto the bush, so do not walk your dogs through these areas.

LONG TERM

At the rate this disease is spreading, it is highly likely that this disease will be widespread throughout Australia within the next 5-10 years. With global warming, brown ticks will become more common even in the southern states. Keep an eye on warnings put out by the Government about where new cases are detected so you can be aware of this real threat to your dogs' health. Tick prevention should become second nature, especially when travelling into areas of high risk.

DOGS AUSTRALIA: IMPORTANT PRESS RELEASE FOR ALL EXHIBITORS, MEMBERS AND FRIENDS.



Dogs Australia has concerns regarding the risk of vectoring Canine Ehrlichiosis through the pedigree dog population attending our major exhibition events such as Royal Shows.

All exhibitors are encouraged to ensure their dogs are treated for tick prevention using a reputable systemic treatment prior to attending such events or travelling into areas where the brown dog tick is known to occur.

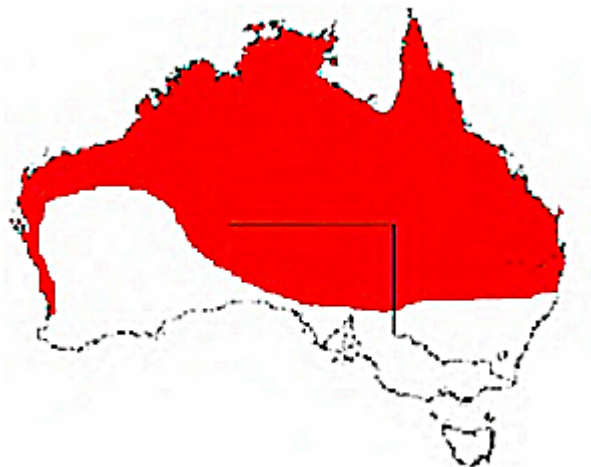
While reputable tick preventions will stop the spread of Ehrlichiosis between dogs, it still relies on the tick biting the dog in the first place to be effective and of course, it's the biting of the dog by the tick which transmits the bacteria.

The disease is characterized by fever, decreased appetite, lethargy and bleeding (such as nose bleeds). Some dogs develop severe and rapid weight loss, swollen limbs, difficulty breathing and blindness. The illness can also affect the bone marrow, which can be fatal. Some dogs die of septicaemia, or they bleed uncontrollably which can also lead to death. Most dogs will improve from treatment with antibiotics and other supportive measures. However, some may develop a chronic infection, which usually has a **terminal outcome**.

People planning to travel through any of the brown tick distribution areas (as shown on this link: Travelling with your dog in Australia - DAFF (agriculture.gov.au), or to events where dogs from other States and Territories will be in attendance should apply systemic tick prevention to their animals prior to attendance.

Dogs travelling through known brown tick distribution areas should also be using a 'Seresto'TM Collar/'Seresto'TM Flea & Tick Collar: **Official Bayer Pet Collar Site** (seresto-store.com) which prevents the parasite from biting the dog in the first place.

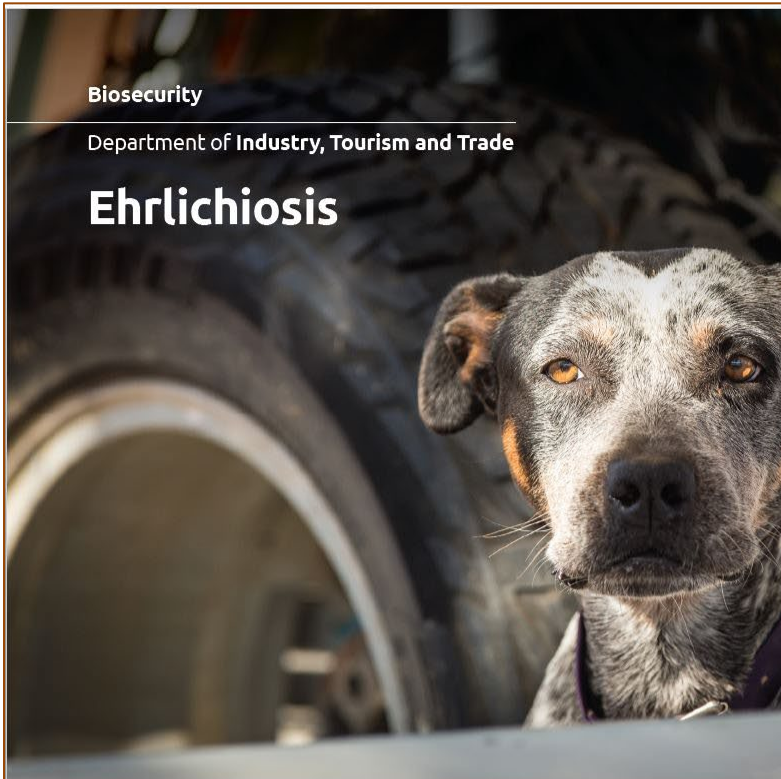
The shaded red area indicates where the brown dog tick is present.

Travelling with your dog

Ehrlichiosis, a tick-borne dog disease, has been detected in the Northern Territory (NT) and is present in all areas, including Darwin, Palmerston, Katherine, Tennant Creek, Alice Springs and remote communities.

Ehrlichiosis is a bacterial disease spread by the brown dog tick. Once the disease is in the brown dog tick population it's very difficult to control.

This disease affects dogs and can result in death if not properly treated. You should take these simple steps to protect your dog when you are travelling in the NT.

Protect your dog from ehrlichiosis

Prevention is the best protection as vaccinations are not available.

- Have your dogs on a tick control program. Tick collars and spot-ons are the best primary protection used in combination with tablets and chews registered for tick control.
- Ensure any tick infestations in the house yard are managed by a pest controller.
- Avoid taking your dogs into tick-infested areas.

Inspect your dogs daily for ticks

- Run your fingers through your pet's coat over their skin, feeling for abnormal bumps.
- Pay attention to the head, neck and ears, chest, between their toes and around their mouths and gums.
- Remove ticks carefully using a tick remover or fine tipped forceps, grabbing it as close to the skin as possible avoiding squeezing the body of the tick.
- Kill the tick by putting it in alcohol, into a sealed container and then into the rubbish.

Travelling or boarding your dog

Before hitting the road:

- Check in with your vet to assess disease prevention requirements such as vaccination, worming, tick and flea control, heartworm preventive.
- When travelling avoid contact with other dogs when stopping, such as at fuel stations, truck stops or caravan parks, to avoid disease transmission between dogs.
- When boarding your dog, make sure their tick, flea and worming preventions and vaccinations are up to date. Check with your local boarding kennel on mandatory disease prevention requirements.

Look out for the signs

- fever
- lethargy
- loss of appetite
- weight loss
- swelling of the chest or front legs
- cloudy eyes or conjunctivitis
- pain and stiffness
- bleeding disorders such as nosebleeds or bruising on the gums or belly.

Human health

The disease cannot be directly passed from infected dogs to humans.

In extremely rare cases, ticks infected with *Ehrlichia canis* may infect people. Human ehrlichiosis is almost always caused by species other than *Ehrlichia canis* and these species have not yet been found in Australia.

Ehrlichiosis

It is important to seek veterinary advice and treatment as ehrlichiosis can resemble other tick-borne dog diseases. Early treatment provides the best chance of recovery.

If you suspect your dog is showing signs of the disease, consult your local vet for further advice about diagnosis and treatment.

DOGS AUSTRALIA SURVEY RESULTS

DOGS AUSTRALIA: JLPP SURVEY RESULTS – ROTTWEILER



Juvenile Laryngeal Paralysis Polyneuropathy (JLPP)

A survey was conducted by Dogs Australia last year to ascertain the feedback from all owners of registered Rottweilers in relation to testing all breeding pairs for Juvenile Laryngeal Paralysis Polyneuropathy (JLPP).

The response received indicated support.

As this was an amendment to current regulations, the result of the survey was referred to the Dogs Australia Board of Directors for consideration at their February 2023 Special Board meeting where it was endorsed.

Consequently, the following new clause will be added to Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration which will be effective from 1 January 2023:

8.17 Effective from 1/1/23

ALL Rottweilers be tested for JUVENILE LARYNGEAL PARALYSIS POLYNEUROPATHY (JLPP) prior to being mated and only Clear to Clear or Clear to Carrier be permitted. The exception to this is Frozen Semen whereby a sample can be taken from leftover semen when a bitch is inseminated and then sent off for testing; in these cases, the bitch must be Clear on the chance the sire may be a Carrier. Certificate to be provided by the Laboratory carrying out testing eg: Laboklin, OFA, Orivet. Samples must be taken by a Vet or a Certified Collector.

DOGS AUSTRALIA CACIB SHOWS**HANDLING DOGS AT CACIB SHOWS**

There has been widespread discussion on the handling of dogs in the ring at CACIB Shows. Under the Dogs Australia Associate Agreement with the FCI, CACIB shows in Australia must be conducted under FCI Regulations, the relevant Regulations from both organisations are as follow:

**DOGS AUSTRALIA: REGULATION'S PART 5 CONFORMATION SHOWS**

Section 9.5.7 In accordance with the terms of the Associate Membership between Dogs Australia and FCI, all Dogs Australia CACIB Shows are to be conducted under FCI Regulations including group nomenclature and breed standards for the duration of the event.

FCI: REGULATION'S PART 12 RESTRICTIONS FOR JUDGES AT CACIB SHOWS

The dogs that a judge handles at an FCI-CACIB show where he is not acting as a judge must be either bred, owned, or co-owned by him, by a partner, by a member of his immediate family, or by any person living with him in his household.

DOGS AUSTRALIA BORDER COLLIE NEWS**BORDER COLLIE BREED STANDARD EXTENSION UPDATE**

The National Breed Standards Coordination Group (NBSCG) received a submission from the National Border Collie Council (Australia) to update the breed standard extension for this breed to bring it in line with the current breed standard.



After reviewing the submission, the NBSCG has agreed to the existing breed standard extension on the Dogs Australia website.

HEALTH SCREENING TESTS FOR BRACHYCEPHALIC
DOG BREEDS**

The University of Cambridge and the Kennel Club (UK) Respiratory Function Grading Scheme provides an assessment for brachycephalic obstructive airway syndrome. to objectively measure the severity of brachycephalic obstructive airway syndrome in dogs and help make a clinical diagnosis. The intent of the scheme is also to improve understanding of the condition, increase awareness, and ultimately reduce the incidence

of BOAS, the scheme has been accepted widely around the world as a viable way of repeatable way of grading dogs for respiratory function.

Dogs Australia (ANKC) with its affiliated State and Territory Members Bodies is the peak body in Australia responsible for Registered Pure Bred dogs and is a not-for-profit organisation advocating for the preservation of purebred dogs through ethical breeding. dedicated to promoting the health and welfare of companion animals through a reduction in the incidence of genetic disease, joined this international effort just prior to COVID and after being delayed by the pandemic is currently rolling out the RFG Scheme in Australia.

As part of its agreement with the Kennel Club, Dogs Australia has appointed Dr Arthur House BSc BVMS Ph.D. Cert SAS DECVS as Australia's Chief Assessor for the RFG Scheme, an internationally recognized specialist small animal surgeon in both Australia and Europe. Arthur recently visited the UK to be briefed on the supervision of the Scheme by Dr. Jane Ladlow the Cambridge University Principal Investigator into Non-invasive Assessment of Respiratory Function in Unrestrained Conscious Brachycephalic Dogs Pre and Post Upper Airway Surgery. Dr. Ladlow gave evidence in the case at which the Norwegian Court of appeal overturned the Bulldog breeding ban.

Dr. House is currently training veterinarians to become approved assessors to carry out respiratory function grading, a number have already been trained and appointed in Victoria, Queensland, and South Australia, and in conjunction with the State and Territory Member Bodies, training will take place in other states in coming months. The response to the launch of the RFG Scheme in Australia has been excellent and the National British Bulldog Breed Council is instituting respiratory function grading as one of its health screening tests.

THE OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHEME IN AUSTRALIA ARE;

- To identify dogs at risk/subject to BOAS to allow for the best care and treatment for managing such conditions.
- To give the breeder/owner the best available information in terms of the appropriateness of using a dam/sire in a breeding program.
- To give other breeders the information resource of dogs affected and unaffected by BOAS to allow for the selection of the most suitable stock for breeding purposes.
- To provide data and statistics in terms of BOAS to monitor the frequency and progress in the breed affected for ongoing research for the overall improvement of the relevant breeds.
