Once upon a time, 7-year-old Junior Handler Chloe Fidler announced to her parents that she “would like a dog of her own”, so, after showing her mum a picture of a ‘fluffy looking Terrier’, the search for the perfect companion began. Chloe was already an accomplished handler, regularly showing Staffordshire Bull Terriers, English Springer Spaniels, Dachshunds (and any other breed she could get her hands on), her parents seized the opportunity to secure a little 7-year-old desexed Norwich Terrier called Gypsy – a far more suitable dog than the Irish Wolfhound Chloe once insisted on handling, and yes! Despite being unable to see over the Wolfhound, the pair still managed to exit the ring with the first-place ribbon!

Well, Chloe put in the hard yards; fine-tuned her handling skills (indeed, she went onto to win the NT State Junior Handler finals (handling an English Springer Spaniel), learning how to hand strip, train, and care for Gypsy, ‘the girls’ formed an amazing bond and became quite the team! Winning many Best Neuter in Show awards, no one had any idea that this pair were about to achieve something quite extraordinary.

One bitterly cold, wet, and windy day in Alice Springs, the duo entered the ring with all eyes upon them – It was silent, you could have cut the air with a knife, then suddenly the crowd went wild! Little Gypsy was crowned Australia’s **FIRST** Neuter Champion! On that grey gloomy day, everything had become just a little bit brighter as those present witnessed Australian show dog history being made. Tears and hugs followed at the realisation that yes! Dreams can come true, provided hard work, training and dedication is applied.

Darling Gypsy retired at the age of 10, and she said her goodbyes at the grand old age of 14. The sight of her and the tiny child making the national history books will never be forgotten.

DID YOU KNOW? The Norfolk Terrier is listed by Kennel Club (UK) as a ‘[Vulnerable Native Breed](#)’? The breeds history originated in the flat agricultural counties of East Anglia. Bred for ratting and to accompany the hunt - but not expected to follow on foot, instead carefully carried by huntsmen in wicker baskets. A cobby little dog, mostly working in agricultural drains – as this presented less of a problem to Terriers of their make and shape. A stocky dog, with sensitive prick ears and a slightly foxy expression. One of the smallest working Terriers, they are keen on small vermin alone or in a pack. With an almost weatherproof coat, curious, alert, affectionate, gregarious, loyal - they are cute to boot as they also appear to wear mascara! Norwich Terriers adapt easily to urban life, prefer the company of humans over other dogs, making the breed ideal for either the city or the bush.

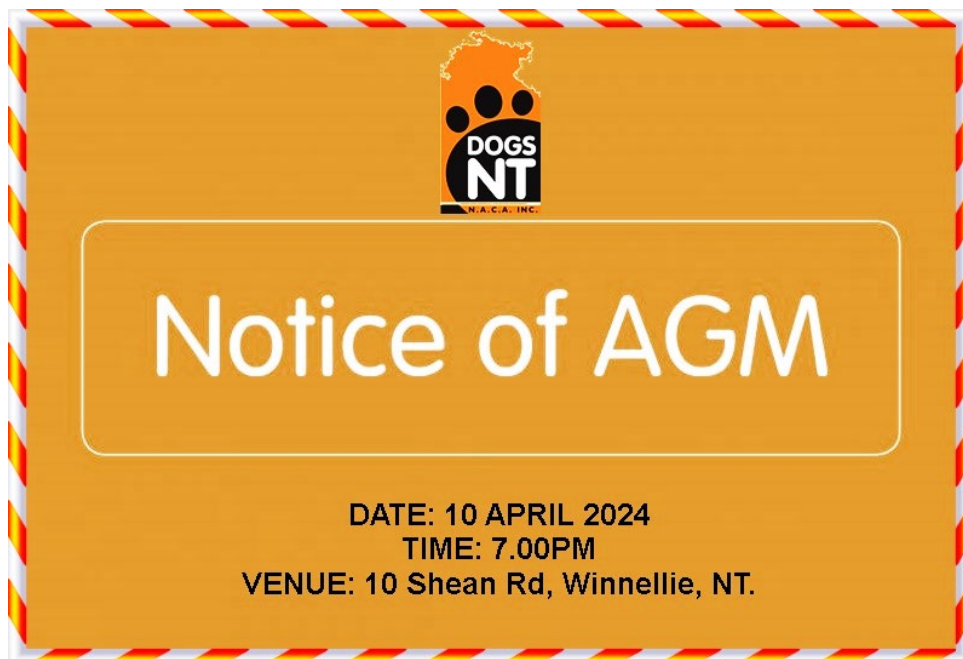

NT GOVERNMENT EMERGENCY PROCEDURE GUIDELINES

NT GOVERNMENT: MAKE SURE YOU CAN RECEIVE EMERGENCY ALERTS! ARE YOU PREPARED? BE WARNED. BE INFORMED.



The Northern Territory experiences some of the world's most extreme weather conditions, from Tropical Cyclones, heatwaves, below-zero ice and frosts, and floods - right through to bushfires and drought.

Your animals are your responsibility. It is up to you to plan and prepare for the safety and welfare of your pets and livestock in times of emergency and/or extreme conditions.

- **REMEMBER:** During a cyclone or flood most, emergency shelters **DO NOT ALLOW PETS** but there are undercover car parks where you can shelter in your car with pets if they are properly restrained.
- In a bushfire situation, there may be different actions you need to take.

Your safety, and that of your family, is paramount. You should not risk your life trying to find and protect pets.

Make sure your pets and animals are properly identified with a name tag, microchip, or brand.

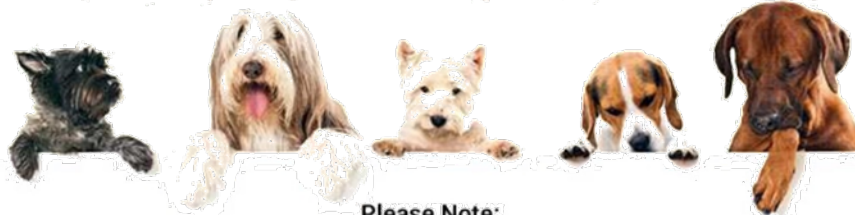
