- → Proposed Special Resolution for the 2024 Dogs NT (NACA) 2024 AGM.
- ❖ PROPOSED BY: Caroline Camilleri, and SECONDED BY: Nicola Jones: To change the wording in the DogsNT Constitution from 'Secretary' to 'Returning Officer':
  - > CURRENT DogsNT Constitution: Part 4 Management Council. Division 2 Tenure of Office: 27 (1): 'A Member is not eligible for election to the Council unless the *Secretary* receives a written nomination for that Member by another Member not less than 63 days before the date of the next Annual General Meeting'.
  - PROPOSED CHANGE DogsNT Constitution: Part 4 Management Council. Division 2 Tenure of Office: 27 (1): 'A Member is not eligible for election to the Council unless the Secretary Returning Officer receives a written nomination for that Member by another Member not less than 63 days before the date of the next Annual General Meeting'.
- \* RATIONALE: This single-word change in the DogsNT (NACA) Constitution will, moving forward, ensure a completely transparent, unbiased receipt of members' written Council nominations, with no conflict of interest regarding Council nominations, particularly when the position of Secretary is up for nomination. This simple constitutional change will also bring the Constitution back into line with both the Dogs NT (NACA) rules and previous Dogs NT (NACA) Constitutions.
