## FEATURING DOG SPORTS – RALLY TRIALS

### RALLY HAS A FAR MORE RELAXED ATMOSPHERE THAN OTHER DOG SPORTS!

**WHAT IS RALLY?** Rally aims to provide a fast-moving and motivational sport for both dogs and their owners, who work as a team to complete various fun exercises in a set course that demonstrates competency in basic obedience exercises. Handlers are allowed to walk the course to become familiar with it before competing. The course is set out with numbered stations including a start and finish and handlers and their dogs navigate the course by following the numbers and carrying out the exercises shown on the sign positioned at each of the numbered stations. Dogs work in the “Heel” position between exercises. Handlers can direct their dog by talking, encouraging with praise and patting is allowed - unless specified in the rules.

At the entry-level (Novice), dogs negotiate a course having between 10 and 15 signs (not including the start and finish) and work on the lead during the test. There is a total of 57 signs available to be placed on a Rally course gradually increasing in complexity as the level of Rally becomes higher.

The higher levels of Rally, Advanced, Excellent and Master use up to 24 signs including many of the more complex ones and dogs are required to navigate the course off the lead with their handlers. In Rally competitors complete the course with their dog while a judge scores the round but doesn't give voice commands or help.

Rally has a far more relaxed atmosphere than other dog sports and each run is a different series of exercises. Owners never know what the course will be until they do the preliminary walkthrough.

**2.6.1** The Council may: -

The Northern Territory experiences some of the world’s most extreme weather conditions, from Tropical Cyclones, heatwaves, below-zero ice and frosts, and floods - right through to bushfires and drought.

Your animals are your responsibility. It is up to you to plan and prepare for the safety and welfare of your pets and livestock in times of emergency and/or extreme conditions.

 **REMEMBER:** During a cyclone or flood most, emergency shelters **DO NOT ALLOW PETS** but there are undercover car parks where you can shelter in your car with pets if they are properly restrained.

 In a bushfire situation, there may be different actions you need to take.

Your safety, and that of your family, is paramount. You should not risk your life trying to find and protect pets.

**Make sure your pets and animals are properly identified with a name tag, microchip, or brand.**

**DOGS AUSTRALIA REGULATIONS UPDATES & AMENDMENTS****DOGS AUSTRALIA: REGULATIONS UPDATES AND AMENEDMENTS****→ REGULATIONS PART 2 - JUDGES, SECTION 3 – AMENDMENT EFFECTIVE: 1 JULY 2025**

In accordance with **Item 7.5.6** of the October 2024 Board meeting minutes, the following amendments have been made to **Section 3 of Regulations Part 2 - Judges**.

→ These amendments will be effective from 1 July 2025.

**Currently reads:**

**3.2** The number of dogs any one judge may judge on any day (excluding Group and General Specials) is 250 exhibits, except in extenuating circumstances with the prior approval of the judge and the Member Body. (09/71) (Amended 10/12 – 7.5.3, 10/13 – 5.6.4) (Amended 10/17, 7.5.7 – Effective 01/01/18)

**Amended to read:**

**3.2.1** The number of dogs any one judge may judge on any day where that judge is only contracted to judge no more than 1 Group (excluding Group and General Specials) is 250 exhibits including Sweepstakes Classes, except in extenuating circumstances with the prior approval of the judge and the Member Body. (09/71) (Amended 10/12 – 7.5.3, 10/13 – 5.6.4) (Amended 10/17, 7.5.7 – Effective 01/01/18).

**3.2.2** Where a Judge is contracted to judge more than 1 Group on any day (excluding Group and General Specials) is 200 exhibits including Sweepstakes Classes, except in extenuating circumstances with the prior approval of the judge and the Member Body.

**10.12.1 Sire of Merit (SOM)** - A dog that has produced at least ten (10) Conformation Champion offspring.

**10.12.2 Dam of Merit (DOM)** - A bitch that has produced at least five (5) Conformation Champion offspring.

**10.12.3** At least 1 of the conformation Champion titles (CH, GRCH, SUPCH, CIB, A2O) must have been awarded after the implementation date (01 January 2025).

**DOGS AUSTRALIA: REGULATIONS UPDATES AND AMENEDMENTS (CONTINUED)****Amended to read:**

**Section 10.12 Sire and Dam of Merit** (Added 06/24, 5.4 - effective 01/01/ 2025)

**10.12.1 Sire of Merit (SOM)** - A dog that has produced at least ten (10) Conformation Champion offspring.

**10.12.2 Dam of Merit (DOM)** - A bitch that has produced at least five (5) Conformation Champion offspring.

**10.12.3** At least 1 of the conformation Champion titles (all conformation titles are included) must have been awarded after the implementation date (01 January 2025).

**DOGS AUSTRALIA PRESS RELEASE**

**DOGS AUSTRALIA: PRESS RELEASE REGARDING DIRECT CONTACT**

Recent discussions regarding members contacting Dogs Australia directly, have highlighted the fact that some members may not be aware of the history and Constitution of ANKC Ltd. An explanation of its relationship with the State and Territory Member Bodies can be found in the “About Us” section on the Dogs Australia website and in the Constitution. We hope the following extracts from them will help members understand why any matters concerning Dogs Australia must be referred to their Member Body.

**HISTORY**

When the original Constitution was drafted in 1958, a vital resolution was, *“That the Australian National Kennel Council be constituted so that it is empowered to act only as a coordinating and recommendatory body”*. Over the succeeding years the Australian National Kennel Council gradually moved in character from an “advisory” towards a “coordinating” body, many changes were made to rules and procedures. In 1982 a new Constitution was adopted which designated ANKC as a Co-ordinating Body. This change of Constitution enabled many decisions to be made which would previously have been rejected. It also led to wide discussion on various issues and areas where ANKC might take control or take over the improvement of certain activities.

The following extract from our **Mission Statement** reinforces that position:

*“To act as spokesperson on all canine related activities on a national basis on behalf of State Member Bodies and to pledge assistance and support to the respective State Member Bodies”*.

**There are 33 Objects listed in the Constitution; the following illustrate the ANKC role as a Co-ordinating Body**

- d) *To act as a federal organization representing the interests of its Member Bodies in each of the States and Territories of the Commonwealth of Australia.*
- f) *To promote uniformity in regard to laws and regulations affecting Dog owners and breeders throughout the Commonwealth of Australia.*



## DOGS AUSTRALIA: PRESS RELEASE REGARDING DIRECT CONTACT (CONTINUED):

*To enable its Member Bodies to take co-operative action on matters which are of common interest and are for their mutual benefit in the promotion of canine affairs.*

A very important item in the Constitution is **Clause 4. Interference with Powers**

This is a long clause, but it is very instructive and recommended reading.

- 4.** *Except where expressly provided in this Constitution, the ANKC shall not interfere with the exercise of the powers or responsibilities of a Member Body, without the express written authority of such Member Body. The ANKC recognizes that Member Bodies have the following exclusive powers in relation to themselves and their activities respectively:*

### LOGISTICALLY

There are currently just over 29,000 members of Dogs Australia Member Bodies, the Dogs Australia office staff consists of the Administrator and a part-time Assistant. The Dogs Australia Directors are appointed by the Boards of their Member Bodies, they have in turn been elected by the members, they are the go-to for Dogs Australia issues.

CHAMPION TITLE (A2O CH) RULES AND REGULATIONS UPDATE**

The A2O Secretariat has provided a copy of the Rules and Regulations regarding A2O Shows. We draw your attention to RULE 4 on PAGE 2, particularly regarding the judging of 'Best in Show'.
