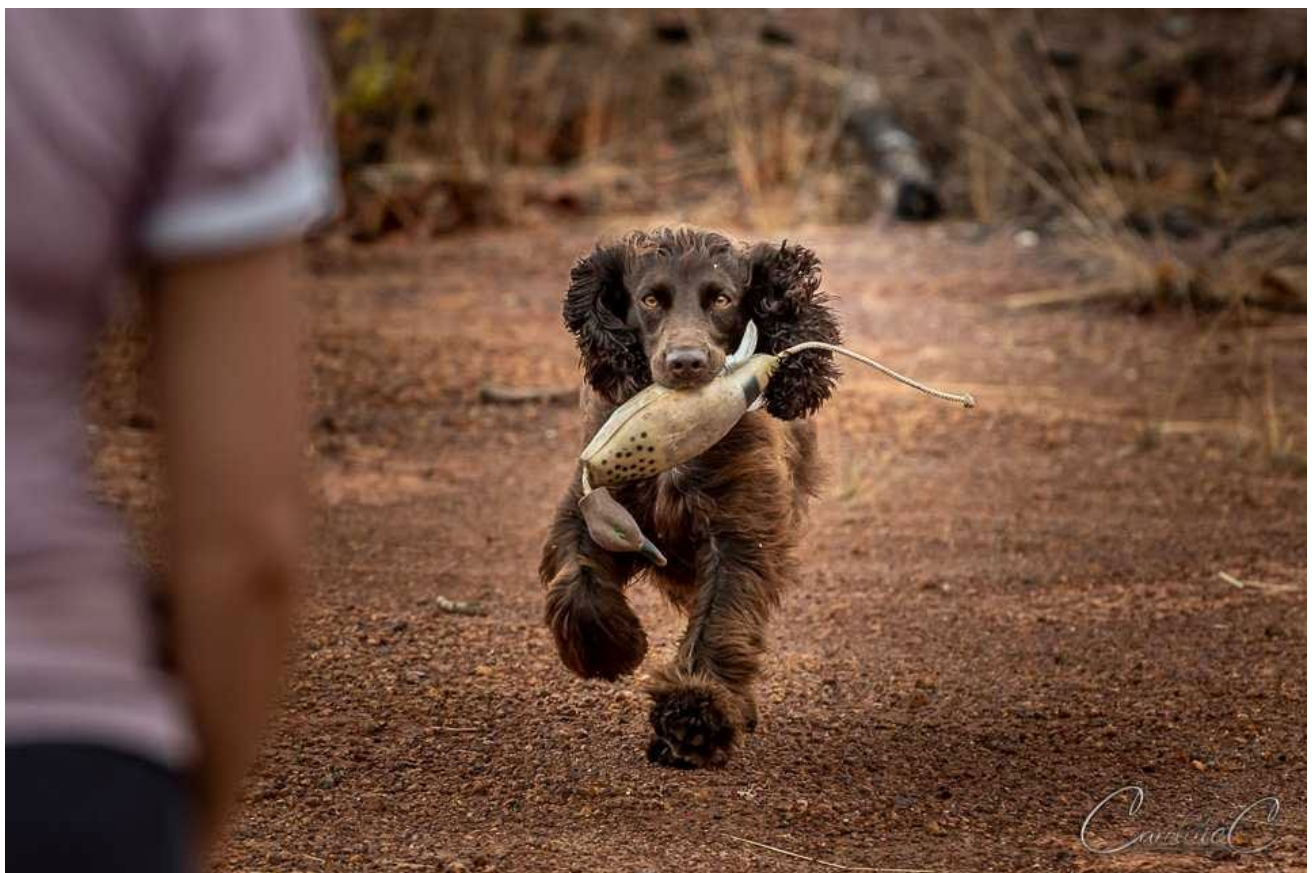
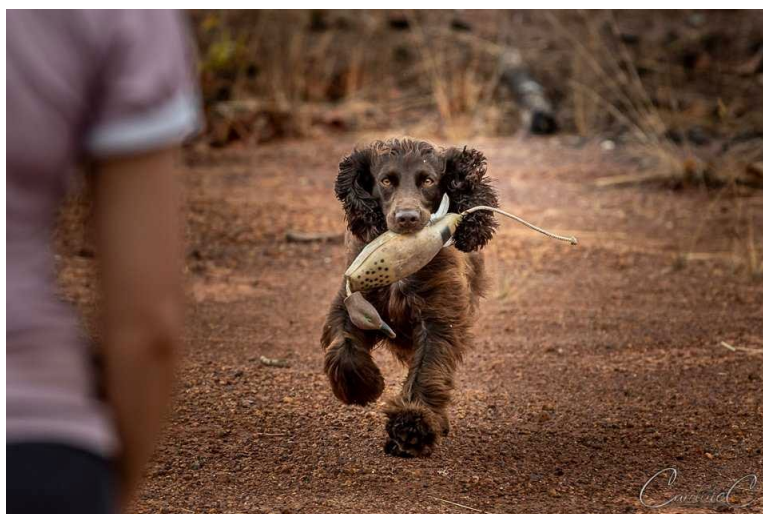

RETRIEVING ABILITY TESTS FOR GUNDOGS [RATG] AND RETRIEVING TRIALS [RT]

RETRIEVING ABILITY TESTS FOR GUNDOGS [RATG]: are a fabulous introductory step into retrieving, testing basic obedience, and retrieving skills with two levels of ability, Novice and Open – with the Open test having slightly more complicated concepts i.e.: double retrieves. Both Registered and Associate gundogs are allowed to compete in these tests. RATGs test the hunting and retrieving abilities of the dogs. In most instances, the retrieves are conducted on approved dummies and are a good starting point for gundog owners who want to become involved with Retrieving or just want to enjoy their dog's wonderful natural ability.

RETRIEVING TRIALS [RT]: are open to all registered gundogs, and are designed to test the working, and retrieving ability of the dogs in a natural environment, both on land and through water. Ideal conditions are ones emulating those that might be found when out hunting. There are three levels of normal competition, with each level increasing in difficulty, from Novice to Restricted through to All Age.

HOW LONG HAVE GUNDOG TRIALS BEEN IN AUSTRALIA? RTs were established in Australia back in the early 1960s, and RATGs, in their current form, have been around for approximately 15 years.

WHAT NATURAL INSTINCTS DO GUNDOG TRIALS BRING OUT? Gundog trials present an opportunity for owners to work with their dogs as a team, in a natural environment, and enhance their dog's natural ability - which both you and your dog will enjoy immensely.

WHY GET INTO RETRIEVING? Gundog-specific trials allow owners and their dogs to enjoy the satisfaction of working as a team, meeting new, like-minded people, and enjoying the unique Australian bush!

IS MY DOG ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE? Retrieving is open to any of the recognised Gundog breeds registered on the main, limited, or associate register (conditions apply), with a Dogs Australia Member Body i.e: Dogs NT.

DOGS NT EASTER AND DOGS



DOGS NT: EASTER AND YOUR DOG

Easter is a wonderful occasion to celebrate with family and friends. At the moment, we are more likely to be enjoying Easter goodies at home. For us Easter treats are a real indulgence, but for our canine friends they can cause health problems. Some foods that are completely harmless to us are a real worry for our pets. It's all to do with their digestive system and the way they metabolise and eliminate the foods. Your dog's body simply isn't able to digest many human foods the same way as we can. So, it is vitally important this Easter to make sure that you and your family are extra vigilant to make sure that any of those special treats (including chocolate bunnies and Easter eggs) are kept well away from your pets. Here are some tips to have a safe and enjoyable Easter at home

We can not emphasise enough just how dangerous chocolate can be for animals, particularly for dogs. It can be any type of chocolate, but cooking chocolate and dark chocolate are the worst. Chocolate contains caffeine and the chemical compound theobromine, both of which are toxic to pets. The most dangerous of all is cooking chocolate (often used at Easter time for baking), it contains the highest level of theobromine. A general rule of thumb is the more bitter the chocolate, the more dangerous it is.

NO-NOS FOR DOGS

While chocolate is the main danger treat this Easter, there are other foods and ingredients that you should be aware of. You might think that traditional hot cross buns should be ok, but they may contain sultanas that can cause kidney problems and can be harmful to pets. Lollies of all kinds are a real worry as well, they can contain xylitol which is an artificial sweetener that is very toxic to pets. Please don't feed your pets any off-cuts or fatty leftovers, bones, garlic, onion or cooking dough – just to name a few. If you suspect your pet has eaten something they shouldn't have, contact your Veterinary Clinic for advice **IMMEDIATELY!**

Instead of giving your pet 'human foods', why don't you treat your dog with some delicious dog treats and put your culinary skills to the test! Remember! Not all human foods & decorations are safe for dogs.

NATIONAL CODE OF PRACTICE OF RESPONSIBLE DOG OWNERSHIP: CLAUSE 14 AMENDMENT.

In accordance with Item 5.9 of the February 2025 Special Board meeting minutes, the National Code of Practice of Responsible Dog Ownership Clause 14 has been amended as follows:

Currently reads:

14. A member shall not breed a bitch causing it to whelp more than six times. (Amended 06/22, 4.2 – effective 01/01/2023)

Amended to read:

14. A member shall not breed a bitch causing it to whelp more than five (5) times.

A breach will result in all progeny of the litter being registered on the Limited Register and marked “never to be upgraded.

This amendment is effective from 1 June 2025.

DOGS AUSTRALIA: UPDATES AND AMENDMENTS CONTINUED:

FEBRUARY 2025 - SPECIAL BOARD MEETING - AMENDMENTS.

In accordance with Item 5.3 of the Dogs Australia February 2025 Special Board meeting minutes, it was resolved that the following amendment to:

Regulations Part 2 – Judges, Section 3 passed at the October 2024 Board meeting, be rescinded:

Currently reads:

3.2 - The number of dogs any one judge may judge on any day (excluding Group and General Specials) is 250 exhibits, except in extenuating circumstances with the prior approval of the judge and the Member Body. (09/71) (Amended 10/12 – 7.5.3, 10/13 – 5.6.4) (Amended 10/17, 7.5.7 – Effective 01/01/18).

Be amended to read:

3.2.1 - The number of dogs any one judge may judge on any day where that judge is only contracted to judge no more 1 Group (excluding Group and General Specials) is 250 exhibits including Sweepstakes Classes, except in extenuating circumstances with the prior approval of the judge and the Member Body. (09/71) (Amended 10/12 – 7.5.3, 10/13 – 5.6.4) (Amended 10/17, 7.5.7 – Effective 01/01/18)

3.2.2 - Where a Judge is contracted to judge more than 1 Group on any day (excluding Group and General Specials) is 200 exhibits including Sweepstakes Classes, except in extenuating circumstances with the prior approval of the judge and the Member Body.”

Therefore, effective from the 1st July 2025, the regulation will revert back to the original wording prior to the October 2024 Board meeting – noted below:

3.2 - The number of dogs any one judge may judge on any day (excluding Group and General Specials) is 250 exhibits, except in extenuating circumstances with the prior approval of the judge and the Member Body. (09/71) (Amended 10/12 – 7.5.3, 10/13 – 5.6.4) (Amended 10/17, 7.5.7 – Effective 01/01/18)
