



Ehrlichiosis

Know the signs

Ehrlichiosis, an exotic tick-borne dog disease, has been detected in the Northern Territory and Western Australia. The bacteria is transmitted to dogs by the brown dog tick and can cause:

- fever
- lethargy
- loss of appetite
- weight loss
- cloudy or sore eyes
- pain and stiffness
- bleeding disorders such as nosebleeds.

It is important to seek veterinary advice and treatment, as ehrlichiosis in dogs can resemble other conditions with similar signs, and if not properly treated, can result in death.
